Rules and Regulations

1. All members, including officers, **MUST SIGN** in upon entering club grounds at all times.
 - a. **Penalties:** two warnings within a one year (Jan. to Jan.) period will constitute suspension of club privileges for six months (surrender of card key).
2. Range rules and range flags*
3. Fishing regulation. (3 Legal size fish a day in season)
4. Use of club for private parties restricted. See List:
 - a. \$100.00 rental fee
 - b. See Building Chairman
 - c. Must clean up after rentals.
5. Club closed to members during rental. (No exceptions)
6. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
7. Persons wishing to use trap must be certified by trap chairman
8. All ranges and pond are closed during work details and rentals.
9. Keep all vehicles off grounds and ranges.
10. Outdoor ranges are open between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. (No shooting before or after these times.)

Range Rules

1. Place range flags on exterior of building.
2. One range (outdoor) at a time in use.
3. Treat all guns as loaded.
4. Follow 10 commandments of safety to the letter.
5. Keep all muzzles down range.
6. Target shooting on ranges only.
7. No glass or can targets allowed.
8. No horseplay.
9. No booze on ranges.
10. When club grounds are rented, all ranges are closed to the membership.

Before Leaving did you?

1. Sign register?
2. Clean up after yourself?
3. Lock all doors and close windows?
4. Shut off all lights?
5. Pay for all supplies (beverages) used?
6. Re-arm burglar alarm?

Rules and Regulations

1. Only members and their guests are allowed to use club facilities; except during rentals. Members are responsible for the actions of their guests. All members, including officers, must sign in upon entering club grounds. Before leaving club grounds all members must: clean up after themselves, make sure all doors and windows are locked, sign out, and shut off all the lights and fans.
2. The use of club facilities for private parties is limited to members and their guests. A \$100.00 fee is required to rent the club house and grounds. A \$200.00 damage deposit is required to insure that the club facilities are left in good order following the rental. Good order includes all the measures in rule 1 (above) as well as the removal of all trash. The member sponsoring the rental must be present throughout the rental and will be held responsible for any damage to club property. During rentals the club facilities are closed to other members.
3. All ranges and the pond are closed to members during work details. Work details are the only times at which vehicles are allowed on the Clubs' ranges. Members are forbidden to drive vehicles on the ranges at any other times. All member vehicles are to be parked in the club parking lot during their use of the club facilities.
4. Safety is the responsibility of all club members. In the case of minor infractions members may attempt to resolve the problem themselves. If such action fails, members should then report the infraction to a club officer or board member. The names and phone numbers of all officers and board members is located just to the left of the main entrance as you enter the club. In the case where the infraction poses an immediate threat to a person or persons or major damage to club facilities, the member(s) observing the action should report it directly to the NY State Police and then notify the most senior club officer possible.
5. The Holland Rod and Gun Club is a self help organization. All members are required to perform 8 hours of work on Club projects and activities during the year. There is a small wooden book to the left of the main entrance as you leave. There are also slips to fill out indicating the number of hours worked. Those who do not fulfill their work commitment will be charged \$4.00 for each hour not worked.
 - a. PS: After you have completed 8 hours there is no need to fill out any more slips. We know who is doing more than their fair share, and we greatly appreciate their efforts. –The Board

Special Conditions for Archery Range and Targets

1. Designated archery flag will be placed outside of clubhouse to indicate that archery range is in use.
2. Use of firearms on any archery range is strictly prohibited.
3. Use of archery equipment on any firearm range is strictly prohibited.
4. Archery range hours are sunrise to sunset.
5. Field archery and 3-D target ranges are open for use while other club facilities are in use during specified hours, except while trap house number 3 is in use. Both archery ranges may be used while other club facilities (trap house 1 & 2, pistol range, pond or rifle range) are in use.
6. Use of broadheads on Morrell Outdoor Range and 3-D targets is prohibited. Field tips only.*
7. Maximum allowable shooters on the field archery range shall not exceed 8 persons.
8. All archers must shoot from the same location if more than one person is using field archery range.
- Broad heads will be allowed only when used in conjunction with designated broadhead targets. These targets will eventually be purchased for future member use.

3-D Target Rules and Regulations

- All 3-D targets will be stored in clubhouse when not in use.
- 3-D targets must be signed out prior to use and signed back in after use.
- 3-D targets must be used only on designated portion (wood area) of archery range that is marked for 3-D target use. This area will be marked with pink flagging tape.
- Steel pegs will indicate where 3-D target shall be placed during use. These pegs are used to hold and position the target during use. These pegs will be marked with pink flagging tape.
- Wooden stakes with marked yardage will indicate the general shooting location for the 3-D target. Archers should do their utmost to shoot from these locations.
- Yardage markers cannot be moved unless authorized by a range officer or voted by approval of Holland Rod and Gun Club Board of Directors.
- Impact of arrows at 3-D targets should always be focused at the marked “core” area of the chest area of the 3-D target. Any unwarranted impacts to other parts of the target will degrade the target prematurely and is strongly ill advised.

All other rules pursuant to the use of Holland Rod and Gun Club equipment and use of ranges will apply.

Any member found in violation of special conditions or 3-D target rules and regulations is subject to disciplinary action (first offense).
